### Where we need you

#### General Description:

- Perform and record applicable testing of incoming raw material samples (resin, paint, etc) and disposition in SAP.
- Contact suppliers to obtain information for testing and molding information.
- Update and maintain material spec sheets.
- Perform and record results of various laboratory testing as needed (tensile testing, salt spray, climate, bottles, etc.)
- Obtain and document test data reports
- Assist with developing and writing test procedures
- Ensure validity to product qualification
- Develop valid analytical test methods for finished products (specifically AGS)
- Create and maintain an analytical test method validation master plan
- Ensure that key timelines in the new product development process, such as stability start dates, are adhered to.
- Coordinate on site and third party calibration of gages
- Maintain Master Standards and List
- Maintain gage calibration and master list information in Engage
- Set Calibration frequency and Calibrate internal gages, fixtures.
- Other duties as assigned.
